SPECIAL PREVIEW! of restored

WISSLER WA-6 BI-PLANE

For Members: Wednesday, January 11th, 6:00-8:00 pm
For General Public: Sunday, January 15th, 1:00-4:00 pm

Several years ago the Logan County History Center acquired local aviation pioneer Clarence Wissler's WA-6 biplane. The plane was in many pieces, in part to the fact the biplane had crashed. The fuselage, or body, was the only part that remained from the original WA-6 biplane. We used a drawing by local aviation historian, Ray Watkins, that showed the basic dimensions and construction of the airplane, as well as photos of it as a guide in our restoration and rebuilding. Since so many of the original parts were missing we used the drawing and photos as guides to reconstruct many parts of the biplane.



After many, many months of the restoration and hundreds and hundreds of volunteer hours, the WA-6 restoration is nearly complete.

We are scheduled to hang the biplane in mid-January. **On Wednesday, January 11th from 6:00-8:00 pm we will have a special preview of the Wissler biplane for Logan County Historical Society members.** Members will be able to see the WA-6 on the ground before we hang it. This will be an opportunity to see this historic aircraft up close. You can even take pictures standing next to the plane. We will then host a special open house **for the public on Sunday, January 15, 2017 from 1:00 to 4:00** in the Transportation Museum Atrium, so that they too can see the WA-6 up close and take their pictures next to the plane.

This project would never have been completed without the many people who donated their time and talents toward the restoration. We will have a complete list of these individuals and companies once the WA-6 is hung. However, we do want to point out a few people who have been the backbone of the project: **DWIGHT HANSEN** has headed up the restoration, recreated many of the pieces and was the primary



builder on the project. **BRIAN BAKER** fabricated much of the metal work on the plane, painted the airplane and worked on the rebuild. Brian is also overseeing the hanging of the plane. **RAY STAMM** recreated many of the wooden components on the plane, including the replica wood engine. We cannot thank Dwight, Brian and Ray enough for all of the work and time they have put into this project.

CURATOR'S CORNER

We are very fortunate to have the complex that we have here at the Logan County History Center. The addition of the Transportation Museum has made the complex even better. We hear many positive comments from our visitors. Perhaps the most common remark visitor's say is they can't believe a community the size of Logan County has such a large and beautiful museum.

Of course a large facility like the Logan County History Center does require a lot of maintenance. We are blessed to have the 0.25 mill operating levy to cover most of our operating costs. However, there are a few projects that go beyond normal maintenance. This summer we will embark on one such project when we replace the tile roof on the Orr Mansion. Much of the tile on the roof is the original tile William Orr put on his new home 110 years ago. However, after more than a century the roof needs replaced. The roof has developed some small leaks, broken tiles have fallen to the ground and a few birds have made their way into the attic through small gaps in the roof and dormers.

We are estimating that the new roofing project will cost about \$160,000. This will include tearing off and disposing of the old tile, making necessary repairs and preparations for the new roof, some masonry work and of course installation of the new tile. One of the neatest things about the project is that the new tile will be the same style and color as the original tile, because the company that made the tiles for Mr. Orr back in 1906 is still in business today and will be making the new tiles for us. While this is a major cost, the new roof should last many, many decades. As stewards of the History Center we feel an obligation to replace the roof at this time.

The Logan County Historical Society's Fundraising Committee has made the roof project their primary goal this year. Many of you may have already received an appeal letter from the committee asking you to donate towards the roof project. If you have not received a letter you will receive one in the near future. We hope that you will contribute to this important project. Once completed it will help ensure that future generations will be able to enjoy stepping back in time as they visit William Orr's "dream home."

On behalf of the LCHS Board of Trustees and staff, I would like to thank all of our members and the Logan County community for their past support and hope your wonderful support will continue with the Orr Mansion Roof project.






